HIST 232: African History since 1880

Surveys the African loss of sovereignty and the establishment of European colonial dominance in Africa. Focuses on economic, political and social distortions resulting from foreign domination. Considers the impact of African reactions to these developments. Special attention to the struggle for independence and the reemergence of independent African states. Prerequisite: An Earlham Seminar or consent of the instructor.
